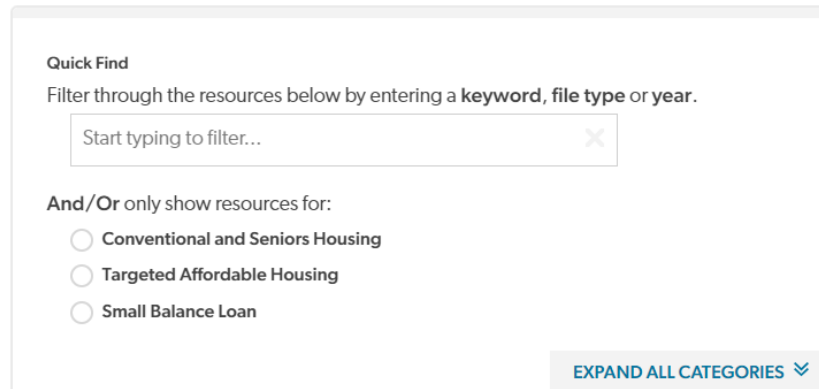
Navigating the Freddie Mac Multifamily Website
